This weekend course is aimed at Newly Qualified Teachers working with young people. Problem solving, adventure, challenge, discovery and fun will be some of the ingredients of the weekend. A coach will pick you up in Haringey on Friday evening and drop you back Sunday evening.

Pendarren House is an Outdoor Education Centre maintained by Haringey Children and Young People's Service. It overlooks the delightful Grwyne valley in the Brecon Beacons National Park in South Wales.

Pendarren House is used by Primary, Secondary and Special Schools from Haringey. The Centre can accommodate up to 60 students and their accompanying teachers.

Primary and Secondary School groups undertake courses involving adventurous activities, including caving, climbing and canoeing or environmental education and geography, history, art or science programmes.
